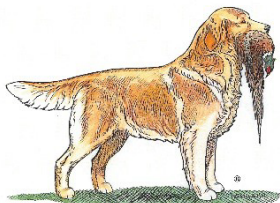

Welcome to the 2024 GRCA National Specialty Hunt Test. This event is hosted by the Golden Retriever Club of America, a member of the Master National Retriever Club and Master Amateur Retriever Club. A specialty hunt test is a special event and requires the participation of volunteers, competitors and dogs from across the country. We thank them all for being part of this event in Sprakers, NY.

We wish to thank those who made this event possible through the generous use of their grounds - Ann and Ellis Ibbotson, Mimi and Frank Kearny, and Pam and Dave Graff. Please respect their properties and only drive on the roads or paths. Park where indicated, air dogs in designated areas and take out your trash. When driving on the local roads please be courteous to others. There is a large Amish community in the area so be careful and go slowly when passing their buggies.

Please join in thanking our judges for their time and effort to travel here to evaluate our dogs. And of course we greatly appreciate the hard work of our marshals, gunners, bird throwers and the many other volunteers who contribute their time and effort to make this event run smoothly. We thank each of you.

All participants and guests are expected to follow AKC Rules and Guidelines relative to their conduct at this event. We ask that the gallery wear dark clothing and refrain from loud noise during the event to avoid distracting the working dogs. Bitches in season are not allowed on the grounds. There will be no training on the grounds at any time beginning 24 hours before the event starts until after the conclusion of all stakes.

WAIT LIST POLICY

GRCA will create a waiting list for MH entries that are received after the test has filled but prior to the published closing date. If, after closing and up to the start of the MH test, there are entries that are known will not be participating, dogs may be taken from the waiting list to run in the position of the absent dogs. ONLY dogs that are on the waiting list are eligible for the open positions (No substitutes). Dogs called from the waiting list shall be prioritized in the order the entries are received. GRCA will contact the next person on the waiting list if known scratches occur after the closing and no later than 48 hours prior to the start of the test. If called, you will have 12 hours to return the call if you want the next position or it will go to the next person on the waiting list and your name will drop to the bottom of the list.

THE MORNING OF THE TEST

If you are on the waiting list and there are last minute openings, you must physically be present at the Master Marshall Board 30 minutes prior to the listed start time of the test to be eligible for the open position. You will need to pay the GRCA with the exact cash or check for the full amount of the listed entry fee plus the \$6.85 Entry Express fee for them to move you from the wait list to the running order before the start of the test.

Running Order The running order will be posted online including the wait list for Master.

Courses and Birds Mallard Ducks and/or pheasants will be used in all stakes

Prizes Orange Rosette and a Bird Band for all qualifying dogs

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
