ENTRY FEE: \$75 for Tracking Dog, \$75 for Tracking Dog Urban; \$150 for Tracking Dog Excellent and \$150 for Variable Surface Tracking which includes AKC recording fee and service fees. Checks payable to GRCA.

CLOSING DATE: 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, September 4, 2024 at the Test Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted.

As required by the AKC Tracking Regulations, a written certification must accompany the TD or TDU entry for any dog which has not previously passed an AKC TD or TDU test.

All entrants submitting certifications should enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope so that unused certifications may be returned.

In accordance with Chapter 1, Section 12 of the Tracking Regulations, the Test Secretary may enter and handle a dog that she owns or co-owns.

No dog may be entered in more than one test on each day. However, under Chapter 1, Section 11, a dog may be entered in more than one test at a combined tracking test where each test is held on a separate day in conjunction with a National Specialty.

SUBSTITUTION OF TRACKS: In the event that there are insufficient TD or TDX entries or insufficient TDU or VST entries, tracks may be substituted using the factor of 2 TDs = 1 TDX and 2 TDUs = 1 VST as specified in Chapter 1, Section 15 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

The drawings for entries and alternates will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17 of the AKC Tracking Regulations. These TD/TDU/TDX/VST Tests are limited to Golden Retrievers.

The drawing will take place at the test secretary's home at 8:00 AM on Thursday, September 5, 2024 or as soon as practicable thereafter, however if the Secretary is entered the drawing will be conducted by another member of the tracking committee. After the entry limit is reached in TD, TDU, TDX or VST, an alternate list will be prepared with positions assigned according to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entries of the results of the draw by e-mail as soon as practicable after the draw.

WITHDRAWALS: Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Test Secretary. If an entry withdraws for any reason between the closing date and the test date and is replaced by an alternate, the entry check will not be used, however, if the entrant is not replaced by an alternate the check will be used. The entry check for an alternate that does not participate will not be used.

ENTRY FEES WILL BE MADE BY CHECK. If you would like your check returned in the event it is unused, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope; otherwise all such checks will be shredded.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations after all other dogs and bitches have been tested. They will be allowed on the tracking fields or urban site only immediately prior to the running of their tracks. Please notify the Test Secretary as soon as you know your bitch is in season for this test.

PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

TROPHIES: The Golden Retriever Club of America will offer a rosette and a glove to each passing team. There will be an additional rosette and trophy for any dog that completes its Champion Tracker title.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
